

(A) Jake Ferguson vs. The State of Texas

I, Jake Ferguson, of the County of McCook, State of Texas, do hereby declare, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by R. A. Neale, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, that I grant, sell and convey and by these presents do grant, sell and convey unto the said R. A. Neale of the County of McCook, State of Texas, all that certain tract of land situated in the State of Texas, McCook County, and a part of the J. L. Barnes Grant, and being the same land conveyed to me by R. L. Barnett and wife Alice M. Barnett, deceased, the 8th day of December, A.D. 1897, and recorded in Vol. 38 on Page 425 & 426, in the Land Records of said County, and beginning at S 10° E cor of tract of land of John T. Pleasant's also the S 6° E cor of James McKnight's home tract, thence west with line of said McKnight's 365 ft to a corner of same, thence S 68° W 90 m to a corner of a tract once owned by W. H. Morris, thence S 35° E 80 ft on a branch of white Oak 6 in A 65 ft 12 in, a white Oak in A 44 ft 11 in thence along said branch with its meanders A 75° E 315 ft to the N.E. boundary line of a tract of John T. Pleasant; thence N 45° E with this line 568 ft, on or back line a Hickory and Bent Elm for witness trees, thence N 11° W 202 ft to corner of John T. Pleasant's 213 line on Ash and Dogwood for witness tree, thence west with said line 688³/11 ft to the beginning containing 160 acres more or less, to hold the above described premises together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereunto belonging but the said R. A. Neale his heirs and assigns forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said R. A. Neale his heirs and assigns against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
