

Isaac S. Mast Letter to Family at Home

To: Ulen, Minnesota
Date: December 6, 1926

Canton Kansas
Dec 6 1926
Dear ones at home
Greetings having just
arrived at the home of
Wm Sandis and read those
two letters written last week
dated Dec 4 & 3, as always
when I go at Means bad
weather, we are getting
it here. We left here at
8:30 wanted to be at Hesston
by 9:45 am for chapel service,
but on account of bad
weather and icy roads
we were 30 minutes late
and missed our opportunity
in an address to the
School.
Well our place we
made a turn the car
obtained a Ford sedan and
just as he brought it to

stayed still it was on
two wheels. but dropped
the right way, I mean
right side up.

I called at the president
office at Heston's Best H. B. B. B.
Alice had a number of calls
just in leaving at 12 o'clock
noon. we met Bowditch Dublin
Florence young and Dorothy K.

after dinner waiting for
a car from Canton. I called
at Mrs. Heston's. Met Figgie
at the door. This was up
town. talked to Figgie a
few minutes. Wanda that
round face of Heston's
old, and care worn. met
this just as we were
leaving the back of and
wrinkled in the face.
Why Wanda cheer up

Mama. That's all I will
write on that subject.

Very damp and foggy
with some rain here
today. I am well but
somewhat tired. Yesterday
Sunday I had three
sermons, in all I had
15 sermons and visited
40 homes. 4 confessions
with possibly 3 more
coming. Yes, if bad
old weather continues
until next week I will
get my ticket for home,
but if it settles to
more favorable weather
there I ought to come
by way of most for

Communion & Baptism,
Durbin and Milv
both said much snow
at Mount + Ferris,
so the south is getting
it this winter.

Now about I have
wrote it all, only you
did not write anything
about hog feed, if
getting down better have
Gibson to get more
at once. So we can
get rid of them two
sows soon.
